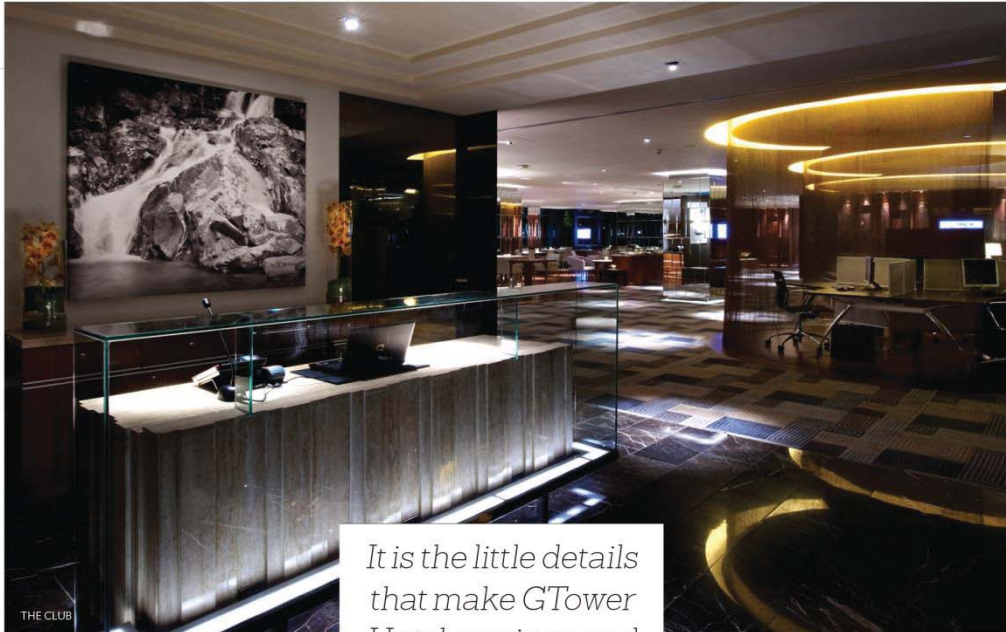

After you have deeply rested yourself for the day, and like to stretch your arms, the hotel's Elements gymnasium that offers a host of equipment as well as one-on-one studio classes and

also a heated infinity swimming pool in addition to the hotel's primary own. Should you decide to have relaxed pampering session, the Sompton Spa offers a range of head to toe treatments catered for both you and your partner.

As evening approaches, GTower opens up to dining at Tanzini or the Upper Deck for a finer dining experience, drinks and music at the View Rooftop Bar or at a more speakeasy session at the Bridge Bar located within The Club.
