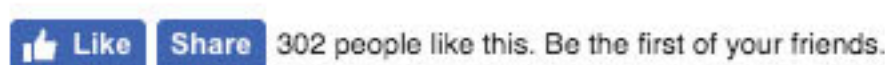




It's Now Possible To Live In An Atas Co-Living Space In KL From RM800/Month

- Rock climbing

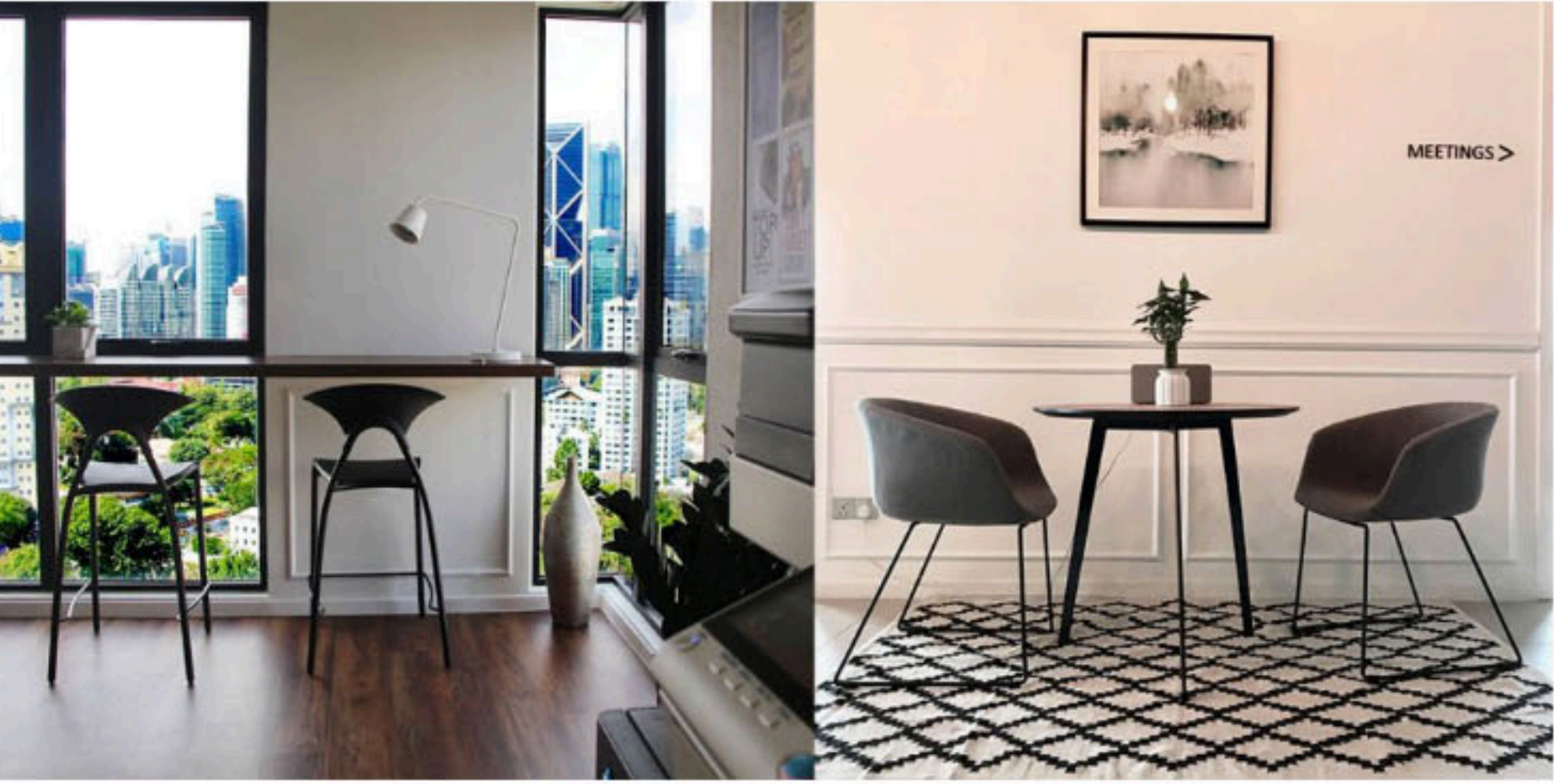
Education

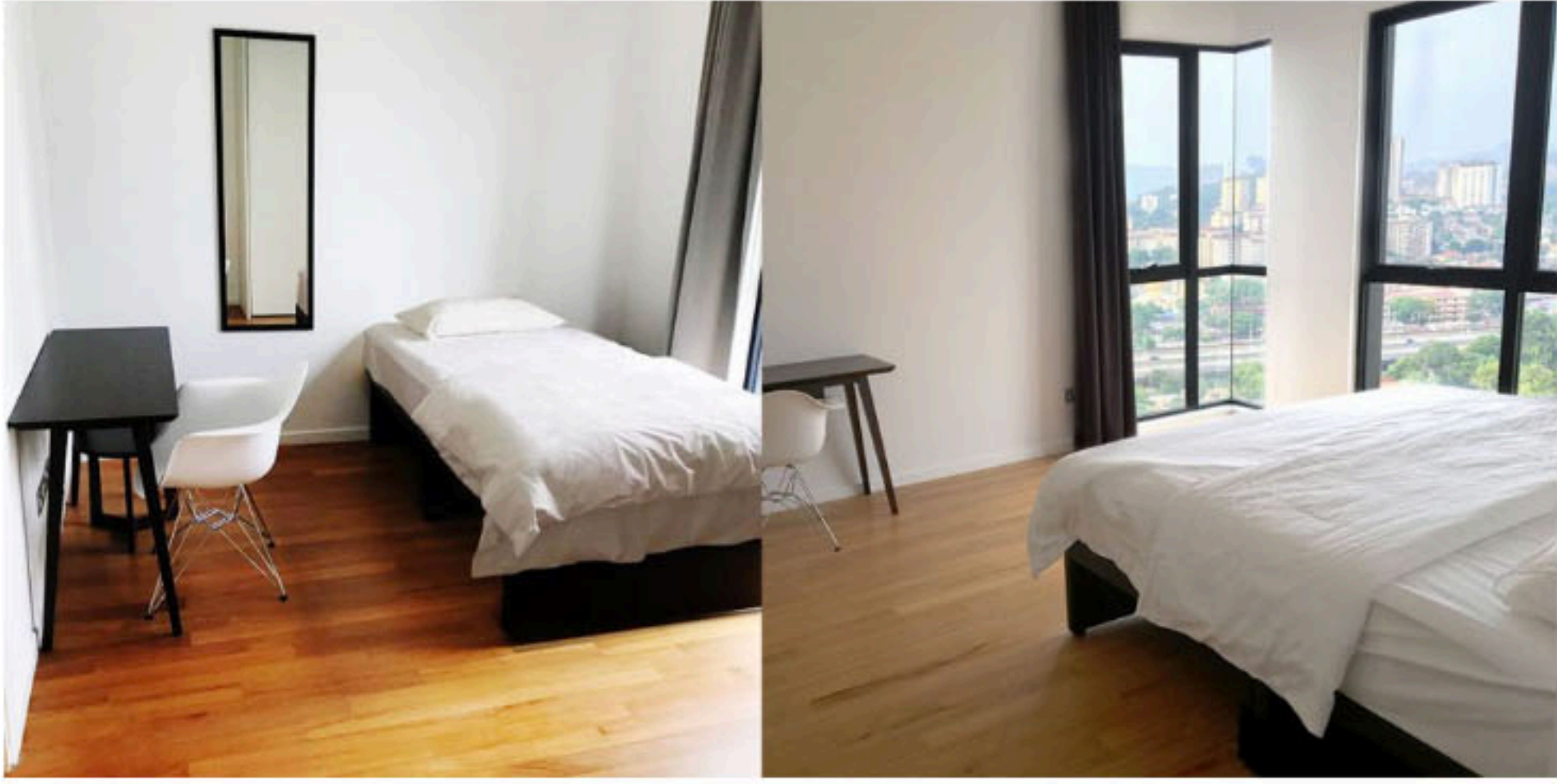


These areas are located at the communal area, Co-Coon Hub @ Level 19. All you'll have to do is bring your own laptops and prepare your own meals with the necessary kitchen appliances and utensils provided.

4. Comfort and security is their priority



Co-living @ Damai Residence ensures that their residence is secured via a phone application with access granted to residents only. Residents will have to download a phone app which works as an access card.



Next, their fully furnished rooms come either with the view of KLCC or Genting Highlands which is pretty sweet either way. Prices of the rooms differ due to three main factors namely the room size, shared or en suite bathroom and the view.

Their fanciest room goes for RM2,500 a month for a double occupancy with an en suite bathroom and a KLCC view. But if you're a single pringle on a budget, you can opt for their smaller single rooms with a KLCC view from RM900 or the garden view for RM800 per month.
